

TWENTY-EIGHTH ANNUAL
PETER & MARY GALASSI SCHOLARSHIP
AND
FRANKLIN B. WALTER ALL-SCHOLASTIC AWARD

OVERVIEW

PROGRAM:

The Franklin B. Walter All-Scholastic Award Program was established by the Ohio Educational Service Center Association to promote student achievement and to recognize outstanding students. A senior from each county within the State of Ohio will receive an award for the 2016-17 school year. The Educational Service Center of Medina County's Governing Board recognizes and supports the recipient of the Franklin B. Walter Award through the awarding of the Peter & Mary Galassi Scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicant must be a high school senior from one of the Medina County school districts (Black River, Buckeye, Cloverleaf, Highland, Medina City, Brunswick, and Wadsworth). Eligible students must demonstrate outstanding academic achievements as indicated by high school grades, test scores, and awards.

AWARD:

One student will be selected from Medina County to attend a special recognition luncheon in Lewis Center, Ohio (recipient and four other persons can attend). Dr. Walter will present the Franklin B. Walter award. The location will be announced at a later time. The Peter & Mary Galassi scholarship will be funded through the ESC of Medina County and presented by the Governing Board.

TIMELINE:

- November 2016 - Notification to all county superintendents
- November 2016 - Applications distributed to high schools
- February 3, 2017 - Applications due to the ESC of Medina County
- February 17, 2017 - Successful applicant's name and application materials mailed to the OESCA offices
- April 12, 2017 - Awards presentation in Columbus, Ohio

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SELECTION PROCESS

1. Each application consists of two parts:

APPLICATION FORM

- a. application form completed by student
- b. activities/awards list by student
- c. personal goal statement of the student

COUNSELOR'S FORM

- a. transcripts of first seven semesters of school
- b. number of days missed
- c. ACT/SAT scores
- d. grade point average
- e. class rank

2. Each application will be read and rated by at least three different reviewers. After the reviewer has read and rated each of the areas, the reviewer will initial the application on the bottom right corner of the front page.

3. Procedures for reviewing applications are as follows:

All applications will be evaluated according to the following scale of one to five, with five being the highest rating a student can receive in one area. A perfect score for all five areas is twenty-five points.
