Note: To apply for the Ohio Reading Endorsement, you must have successfully completed (a) the 12 hours of Reading required by the State of Ohio, (b) Ashland's Reading Endorsement comprised of two courses (EDCI 663 and EDCI 664) and the EDCI 611 Internship completed within your licensure area, and (c) the appropriate Praxis II Reading test.
