## County Fair Honors Ensembles Ready for July 31<sup>st</sup> Fair Performance

The **Medina County Schools' Fair Honors Ensembles** will perform in concert at **12 noon** (elementary ensembles) and **1 p.m.** (junior high/middle school and youth ensembles) in the **pavilion** of the County Fairgrounds on **Thursday, July 31, 2008**. More than 270 students will participate in this year's ensembles. The event is being held with the support of Kovack Realty, Medina County Agricultural Society, Medina Music, Royalton Music Center, Sandridge Food Corporation, United Sport Apparel, and Mr. and Mrs. Joe Warner.

The honors staff includes: **Pamela Haberkorn**, vocal music teacher with Buckeye Local Schools; **Amy McArtor**, instrumental music teacher with Wadsworth City Schools; **Michael McClintock**, vocal-general music teacher with Highland Local Schools; **Alice Rudolph**, band director with Strongsville City Schools; **Corey Rudolph**, Medina High School student; and **Nancy Schneider**, organist with Medina United Methodist Church.

**Michael McClintock** and **Pamela Haberkorn** will be conducting the **Fair Honors Elementary and Youth Choirs**, with **Nancy Schneider** serving as accompanist. **Amy McArtor** will be conducting the **Fair Honors Elementary and Junior High/Middle School Bands**, with **Alice Rudolph** serving as assistant director and **Corey Rudolph** serving as band assistant. The honors ensembles are under the supervision of **Marcus L. Neiman**, Director of Fine Arts Tours and Festivals for the Medina County Schools' Educational Service Center, with **Amy McArtor** serving as assistant coordinator. **Brenda Zacharias**, administrative secretary for the Fine Arts Tours and Festivals, is providing logistical assistance.

A special feature this year will be the premier performance of a newly commissioned work in memory of Mrs. Christine Judd, who conducted the Fair Honors Choirs for 15 years. The work was composed by Tadd Russo and inspired by a setting by Adam Judd. The junior high/middle school band and youth choir will perform the commissioned work at 1 p.m.

According to **Marcus Neiman**, *"Students were selected for membership in these ensembles by their school music director on the basis of their ability to play or sing. We are very pleased with this year's ensembles!"*

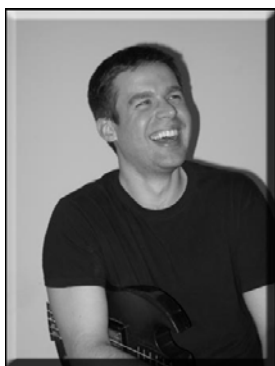
## 2008 Honors Ensembles Ready to Perform

Neiman commented: *"We all were deeply saddened with the loss of our colleague and friend Chris Judd. As we worked through our grief, we felt that we would seek out a composer and commission a work for band and choir that would be premiered by the Fair Honors Ensembles in memory of Chris. Her love for her students, dedication to music education in our community, and support of the Fair Honors Ensembles would live on and provide enjoyment for other audiences. Chris and I were colleagues for a long time; I found her to be among the most dedicated and talented individuals who worked in the Medina County Schools. When I thought of who would make the ideal person to work with the Fair Honors Ensembles and who would I want to work with my own children, Chris' name was always on top of the list. Her spirit will always be part of the Fair Honors Choirs."*



*"It was determined that **Tadd Russo**, who was raised in Medina and graduated from Medina High School (1994), was the logical choice as the composer for our commission."*



**Tadd Russo** (b. 1976) currently serves as a staff arranger with the United States Air Force Band in Washington, D.C., and teaches music technology at Morgan State University in Baltimore, Maryland. He completed his master's degree in composition at The Ohio State University, where his principal instructor was Thomas Wells. His music has been performed at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, the NOW new music festival (Capital University), the OCEAn festival (Oberlin Conservatory), the Electrolune Festival (Lunel, France), the Contemporary Music Festival (The Ohio State University), the Society of Composers National Convention (San Antonio, Texas), and the Ohio Music Education Association Conference (Columbus, Ohio), and by the Dallas Wind Symphony (Dallas, Texas). As an arranger, he has worked with Ben Vereen, Ronan Tynan, the San Juan Children's Chorus, Empire Brass, and Kool and the Gang, among others. Tadd was raised in Medina and graduated from Medina High School in 1994. He currently resides in Baltimore, Maryland, with his wife, Erica, and daughter, Rachel.

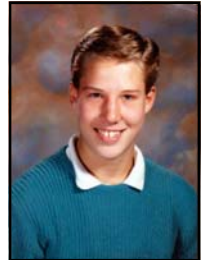
## 2008 Honors Ensembles Ready to Perform

Russo commented: *"Go N-Eírí an Bóthar Leat* was commissioned by the Medina County Schools' Fair Honors Ensembles in memory of Mrs. Christine Judd. Mrs. Judd was director of the Fair Honors Chorus, and the mother of Adam Judd, one of my classmates in high school and graduate school and one of my closest friends. Adam and I were involved in many of the same activities revolving around music and theatre, and our parents were always the first to show their support. Mrs. Judd even took on the job of music director for the high school musicals while we were there.

*"I cannot imagine a more appropriate way to honor the dedication and love that Mrs. Judd displayed to her family, students, and friends than through song with a text filled with such meaning to her and to her family, and by an ensemble to which she devoted many years of service. We are all greater for having had her in our lives and grateful for the opportunity to know her.*

*"The text combines the traditional Irish blessing ("May the road rise up to meet you"--a favorite of Mrs. Judd's) with the Irish prayer in time of sorrow. I drew my inspiration for this work from a setting of the blessing by Adam Judd that was performed by Mrs. Judd's elementary school chorus. This setting grows out of Adam's harmonic sequence and takes a similar view of structure. The instrumental accompaniment is traditional in nature, encouraging a sense of calm reflection and enduring optimism."*

Adam Judd, son of Chris, commented, *"Any child's perspective of a parent changes as he navigates childhood and adolescence, becomes an adult, and can finally realize his parent's love for him as he becomes a parent himself. Because of our shared passion for music and teaching, my mother's passing has left me mourning not only a beloved parent and my children's grandmother, but also my first music teacher, sometime duet partner, teaching mentor, and colleague. It has been truly gratifying to realize just how much the Medina community appreciate Mom's contributions as a teacher and choral director. Perhaps*

The texts that Tadd has chosen and his skillful setting are a fitting memorial; the music is suffused with beauty, friendship, remembrance, blessing, farewell, and--above all--a love for the art of making music. It will be a thrill to hear these accomplished students bring the work to life."*

Amy McArtor, assistant coordinator of the Medina County Schools' Fair Ensembles and conductor of the Fair Honors Bands, commented: *"I was so blessed to have worked with Chris Judd for seven years as directors and was always so impressed with her creativeness, dedication, and enthusiasm with her students. Chris' passing was an enormous loss to all of us who had the privilege of working with her and to music education in Medina. I am very excited and honored to be premiering **Go N-Eírí an Bóthar Leat** in memory of Christine Judd and look forward to sharing this beautiful piece with the students of the Medina County Fair Honors Ensembles."*

Michael McClintock, conductor of the Fair Honors Choirs, commented: *"It is a true honor to be working on this commissioned piece on many levels for me. I went to high school with the composer, and it is exciting to be teaching a piece that someone I know personally wrote. I also went to high school with Adam Judd and was in a couple of musicals with him. Chris Judd was the music director of those musicals. So there are many connections in regards to this piece of music. Chris was a blessing to all those who came in contact with her. This piece is already being well received after only one day of rehearsals. I look forward to working with Tadd Russo, the composer, as we approach the fair performance day, and I urge any of you who had Chris as a private music teacher, attended Ella Canavan Elementary School, are on staff at Canavan, had Chris as your church choir director, or had her as a music director in your high school musical to come to this performance to show your support of music and the work that she began with the Medina County Fair Honors Choirs."*

Christine M. Judd, wife of Patrick Judd and daughter of Foster and Mary Lou McElfresh, passed away Friday, November 10, 2006, at Medina General Hospital at the age of 56. Since moving to Medina with her family in 1988, Christine taught elementary music at Ella Canavan Elementary School. During her tenure there, Christine directed the annual fifth-grade musical—in many cases comprised of her own arrangements and adaptations—and founded an extracurricular honor choir. Christine was the director of the Medina County Honors Choirs and led their performances annually at the Medina County Fair. She also had previously served as minister of music at First Christian Church of Medina. Christine belonged to the Ohio Music Educators Association and the Red Hat Society and was a vocalist in the musical duo Kindred Spirits. Christine also was active at Camp Christian, where she served annually as an assistant director.

Christine is survived by her husband of 35 years, Patrick Judd; mother, Mary Lou McElfresh; brother, Timothy McElfresh; sister, Rebecca McElfresh; children, Adam Andrew Judd, Sarah Elizabeth Bowman, and Bethany Suzannah Judd; and grandchildren, Andrew Judd, Ivan Bowman, Rosalie Judd, and Henry Bowman.

The new work will receive its premiere performance on Thursday, July 31, at 1 p.m. in the pavilion. The concert is free with admission to the Fair.
