#### SCHOOL PROPERTIES DISPOSAL

The Board believes that the efficient administration of the ESC requires disposition of property and goods no longer necessary for the maintenance of the educational program or operation of the ESC.

The Board recognizes that most unused property of the ESC has value and that it may be practical to retain such property for a period of time. Once property is no longer needed for school purposes currently or in the future, it should be slated for disposal at the Superintendent's discretion. State law governs the retention and method of disposal of the Board's property. Property and goods purchased with federal funds also are subject to the disposal requirements outlined in the Uniform Guidance issued by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget. Therefore, the Board follows the procedures required by the various statutes governing the disposal of real or personal property.

The Board follows the procedures set forth in State and Federal law for the disposal of real or personal property at the minimum dollar value set forth in the statute on the date the Board decides to dispose of the property. The Board is required to offer its real property for sale to all community schools, college-preparatory boarding schools, STEM and STEAM schools for the period of time set forth in law. High-performing community schools as defined by State law, are given first priority. If a high-performing community school is not interested in buying the property, the Board then proceeds with offers to purchase from other start-up community schools operating in the ESC, college-preparatory boarding schools, STEM and STEAM schools located within the territory of the ESC. If no community school, college-preparatory boarding school, STEM or STEAM school is interested in buying the property, the Board may sell its real or personal property at a public auction, following specific statutory requirements if the property exceeds \$10,000 in value. If this statutory threshold is changed by the legislature, the Board and administration's responsibility changes automatically to reflect the new minimum statutory dollar value.

The Board directs the periodic review of all ESC property and authorizes the disposition by sale, donation, trade or discard of any property not required for school purposes.

The ESC complies with State law regarding the sale or lease of unused school facilities to high-performing community schools, community schools, college-preparatory boarding schools, STEM and STEAM schools.

#### Disposal of Property Valued at Less Than the Dollar Value Set Forth in State Law

For the disposal of property that is not governed by Federal law, the Ohio Revised Code or administrative regulations, the administration is required to follow these procedures:

 The Superintendent determines that the value of the property is less than the value set forth in State and Federal law when applicable. The property is valued pursuant to a reasonable method as determined by the Superintendent.

- 3. The Superintendent sells the property to a start-up community school or by bids, general sale, negotiated sale or by trade as determined by the Superintendent or the Board on an individual basis.

#### STAFF CONDUCT

All staff members have a responsibility to make themselves familiar with, and to abide by, the laws of the State of Ohio, the policies of the Board and the administrative regulations designed to implement them.

The Board expects staff members to conduct themselves in a manner, which not only reflects credit to the Educational Service Center, but also presents a model worthy of emulation by students. Staff members are not permitted to bring a deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance into a school/ESC safety zone unless permitted by law.

All staff members will be expected to carry out their assigned responsibilities with conscientious concern. Essential to the success of ongoing school operations and the instructional program are the following specific responsibilities, which will be required of all personnel.

- 1. faithfulness and promptness in attendance at work;
- 2. support and enforcement of policies of the Board and regulations of the administration;
- 3. diligence in submitting required reports promptly at the times specified;
- 4. care and protection of ESC property and
- 5. concern and attention toward their own and the ESC's legal responsibility for the safety and welfare of students, including the need to ensure that students are under supervision at all times.

#### **Student Dress Code**

School dress should enhance a positive image of the students and the District and not threaten the health, welfare and safety of the members of the student body. Any form of dress or grooming that attracts undue attention, prompting a disruption of the learning environment or violating the previous statement, is unacceptable.

Requirements include the following.

- 1. Dress and grooming standards require cleanliness in the interest of health, sanitary conditions and safety requirements.
- 2. #### Uniforms

The principal, after consultation with a building committee, may decide to implement a uniform requirement within the building. The committee, composed of the principal, teachers and parents, must request specific Beard approval prior to implementing a uniform requirement. The request must be approved by the Board at least six months prior to the implementation date. The request presented to the Board may:

- include a detailed and specific description of the uniform;
- 2. include a plan and funding source(s) for providing uniforms for students unable to pay for them:
- 3. be consistent with provisions of the District's dress and greening standards and
- establish a process for a parent/guardian to seek an exemption from the uniform requirement or to transfer his/her child, contingent on available space, to a coheel that does not require students to wear uniforms.

Students participating in a nationally recognized youth organization may wear the organizational uniform on days the organization has a scheduled function.

#### **Funding**

District funds shall not be used to purchase uniforms without specific approval by the Board. The funding source for providing uniforms for students unable to pay may include one or more of the following:

- denations, gifts or grants;
- 2. funds generated at the building level by students, staff, PTA/PTO's or business/semmunity partners or

3. any other source as approved by the Board,

**NOTE:** Senate Bill 181 (2022) enacts Ohio Revised Code Section (RC) 3313.5317, which prevents entities that regulate interscholastic athletics from prohibiting student participants from wearing religious apparel during events, unless wearing the apparel would create a legitimate danger to other participants. If such a danger is identified, all reasonable accommodations must be offered to the participant wearing religious apparel.

If a district wants to implement a uniform policy the District must follow the requirements of RC 3313.615:

- Any specific uniform selected for a school must be determined by the Board after affording ample opportunity for principal, staff and parents to offer suggestions and comments.
- No specific uniform can be required in any school until the parents of the students in the school have been given six months' notice.
- No specific uniform can be required in any school unless the Board includes a procedure to assist parents of economically
  disadvantaged students to obtain uniforms in the Board adopted uniform policy. This procedure may include using school
  district funds or funds from other sources to provide this assistance.
- Any policy requiring uniforms must provide exceptions for students participating in a nationally recognized youth
  organization that establishes its own uniforms, on those days that such organization has a scheduled function.

Districts implementing a uniform policy should include language addressing the above requirements in this policy.

#### PUBLIC CONDUCT ON EDUCATIONAL SERVICE CENTER PROPERTY

All persons on ESC grounds are expected to abide by all applicable laws, local ordinances, Board policies and ESC and building regulations.

No person on ESC property may assault, strike, threaten, menace or use improper, indecent or obscene language toward a teacher, instructor, other ESC employees or students at any time. This prohibition is extended to all athletic officials, coaches and athletes in the ESC and all visiting teams.

Unless otherwise permitted by law, no person is permitted to bring deadly weapons or dangerous ordnances into a school safety zone.

No person may disrupt, disturb or interfere with the teaching of any class of students or any other activity conducted in a school building or upon the campus or grounds at any time.

Whoever violates this policy and/or building regulations will be asked to leave the property by whoever is in charge. Should that person refuse, law enforcement officials will be called. If the offender should be a student, the person in charge should report the student to the appropriate principal. The administration cooperates in any prosecution pursuant to the criminal laws of the state and local ordinances.

#### Good Conduct and Sportsmanship

The Board recognizes the value of cocurricular and extracurricular activities in the educational process and the values that young people develop when they have the opportunity to participate in an organized activity outside of the classroom.

Students and adults participating in cocurricular and extracurricular activities are expected to demonstrate responsible behavior and good conduct. The Board encourages the development and promotion of sportsmanship in all phases of the educational process, including athletics and all other cocurricular and extracurricular activities. Rules are posted at the entryways to all athletic events for all participants and spectators to review.

# AGREEMENT between CASE WESTERN RESERVE UNIVERSITY FRANCES PAYNE BOLTON SCHOOL OF NURSING and MEDINA EDUCATIONAL SERVICE CENTER

#### GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A. Case Western Reserve University on behalf of its Frances Payne Bolton School of Nursing ("SCHOOL"), with a primary place of business located at 10900 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, OH, 44106-7343, and Medina Educational Service Center ("FACILITY"), with a primary place of business located at 124 West Washington Street, Medina, OH 44256, agree to cooperate in the provision of clinical experiences for undergraduate and/or graduate students.
- B. The SCHOOL and the FACILITY shall agree on the terms of the use of preceptors for the use of any precepted learning experiences.
- C. This agreement will be in effect two (2) years beginning on September 1, 2022. The parties may extend this agreement for additional terms. Either party may terminate this agreement by notifying the other party in writing sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of termination. The parties agree that the timing of termination will occur in a manner so that students' learning experience will not be jeopardized.
- D. This agreement is not assignable but is binding on the successors of the parties. This agreement is not a third-party beneficiary contract and confers no rights upon any students or employees of the parties.
- E. The parties agree not to discriminate on the basis of race, religion, age, sex, color, disability, sexual orientation, national or ethnic origin, political affiliation, or status as a veteran.
- F. This agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio without regard to its conflict-of-law provisions and exclusive venue. Jurisdiction for any litigation arising out of this agreement shall be in a court of competent jurisdiction located in Cuyahoga County, Ohio.
- G. The agreement may not be amended or modified without the written consent of the parties thereto. This agreement supersedes all previous agreements between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.

#### II. SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES

A. The SCHOOL will work with the FACILITY to plan appropriate orientation of students and define their proposed clinical experience. The names and academic standings of students and exact dates and times clinical areas will be utilized during each respective semester will be submitted to the FACILITY prior to the beginning of each semester.

- B. The SCHOOL will assume responsibility for validating that students practicing in the FACILITY have current professional/personal liability insurance, so long as the student is acting solely in an educational capacity on behalf of the SCHOOL.
- C. The SCHOOL will assume responsibility for ascertaining that the students involved in educational experiences at the FACILITY are in satisfactory health. The SCHOOL will inform students that they may have to provide, or consent to the disclosure of, student health records as necessary verifying compliance with the FACILITY student health policy.
- D. When students are assigned to a qualified preceptor or other clinical supervisor at the FACILITY, the SCHOOL will ensure that the course clinical objectives are communicated to the student and the preceptor or other supervisor as appropriate. The SCHOOL will be responsible for the final evaluation and grading of the student. The SCHOOL is responsible for ensuring that the identified preceptor or supervisor meets the minimal qualifications as prescribed in the Ohio Board of Nursing Rules on clinical supervision of students.

#### III. FACILITY RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. The FACILITY will provide, without cost to the SCHOOL and its students, clinical resources and facilities for use in their educational experiences. The FACILITY will provide adequate orientation for the SCHOOL faculty and students at the beginning of the students' assignments. The FACILITY will ensure that the student's clinical experiences is supervised by a qualified preceptor or other clinical supervisor, and that a written performance evaluation is completed for each student in the form and within time limits specified by the SCHOOL.
- B. The FACILITY may, after discussion with the SCHOOL, terminate clinical privileges of any SCHOOL students whose performance is unsatisfactory or whose behavior presents a danger to the interests of the FACILITY or its patients.
- C. The SCHOOL's students will actively participate in the care of patients in accordance with the guidelines set forth by the FACILITY, provided however that the students shall at all times be supervised by appropriate and qualified FACILITY personnel. The FACILITY retains ultimate responsibility for the care of all patients, including those assigned to students. The FACILITY agrees to carry professional liability insurance coverage and comprehensive general liability insurance with annual limits of no less than \$1 million/\$3 million and shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the SCHOOL from and against any claim, liability, demand, damage, expense, proceeding, legal actions, attorney's fees, court costs and other fees arising from and out of this agreement. The FACILITY will provide a copy of the insurance certificate to the SCHOOL upon request.
- D. The FACILITY understands that information received from the SCHOOL regarding students participating in clinical education is subject to the provisions of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, and the FACILITY agrees to use such information only for the purpose for which it was disclosed and not to make it available to any third party without first obtaining the student's consent. Health records will be destroyed following the completion of the student's experience.
- E. The SCHOOL acknowledges that the FACILITY is obligated to comply with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 ("HIPAA") and the related regulations,

as they may be amended from time to time. The FACILITY agrees to provide appropriate training on HIPAA to students.

F. The FACILITY agrees to inform the SCHOOL in writing of any policy or procedural changes that would significantly affect the students' obligations or terms of the clinical education.
