SB 104 Originally made changes to the College Credit Plus system. The House added the Protect All Students Act regarding single sex bathroom access

HB 78 This bill would make retired teachers reemployed in positions by STRS eligible to seek election to STRS Board

SB 295 Closure requirements for poor performing community schools and school buildings operated by a school district. Poor performance for 3 conservative years. Will allowed to stay open if:

Principal and majority of licensed staff are replaced. The district could consolidate with another school.

Transportation amendment...change the process and procedures for declaring students impractical to transport.

Ohio Schools Council is trying to work with BASA, OSBA, and OASBO to get better utility rates for schools through Power 4 Schools...not sure this always ends up in cheaper rates (but we'll await the end result).

SB597 The Social Security Fairness Act. The government Pension Offset and the Windfall Elimination Provision. House passed HB 82 and is half way through Congress.
