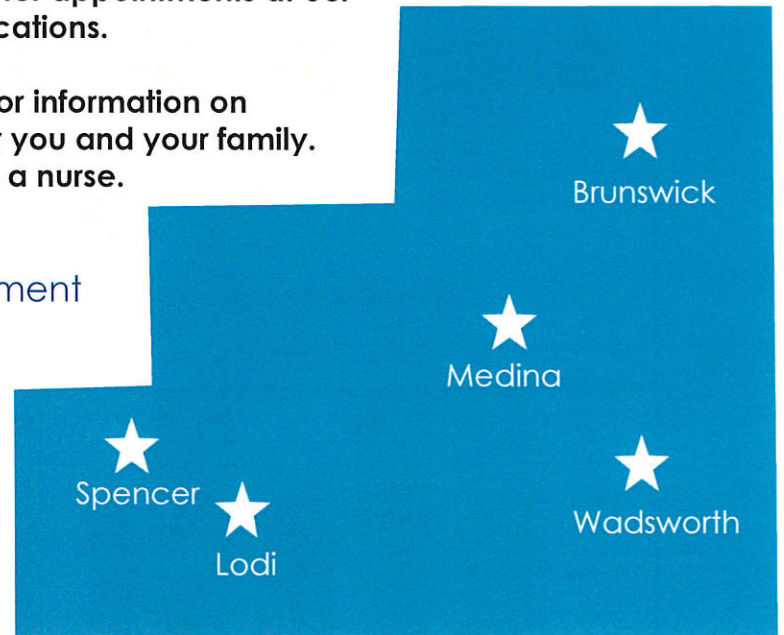

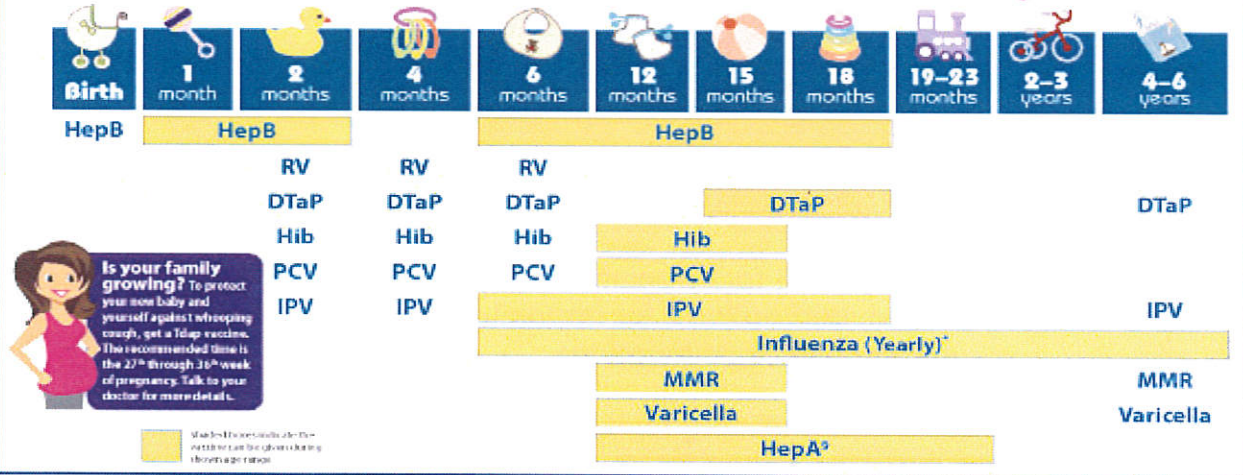

We accept cash, check, Medicaid, and many commercial insurance plans. No child will be denied immunizations due to the inability to pay.

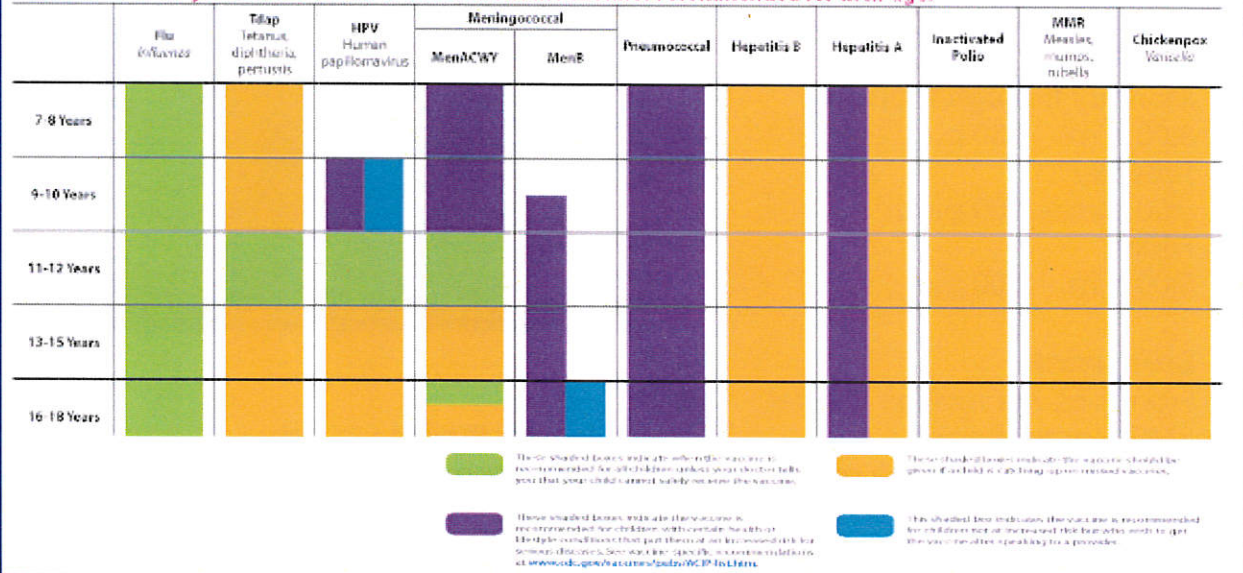
2017 Recommended Immunizations for Children from Birth Through 6 Years Old

Talk to your child's doctor or nurse about the vaccines recommended for their age.

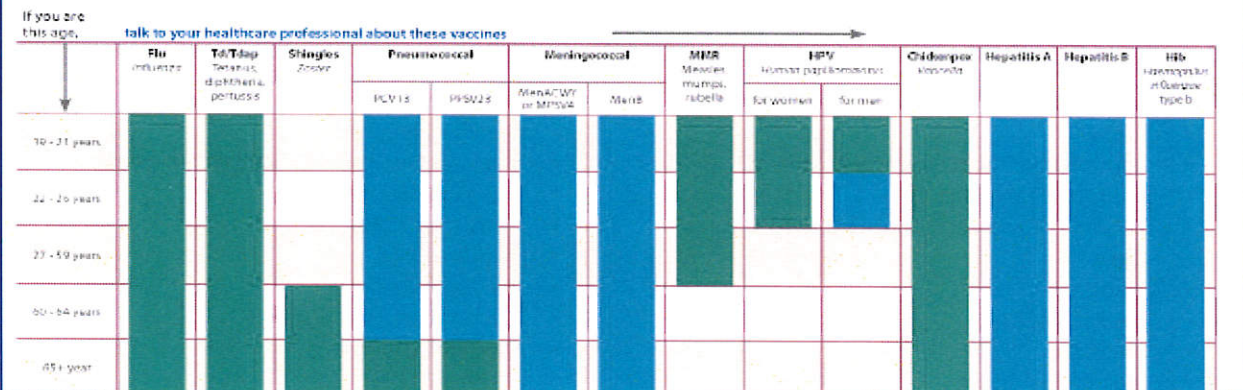


Recommended For You: This vaccine is recommended for you unless you have a medical condition that tells you otherwise or you could not get it.
