Summer Enrichment Program Serves a Record Number of Students!

In 2012, the ESC welcomed four students to participate in a new summer enrichment program. This program provided direct instruction in social skills, self-regulation, and specific IEP goals for middle school students who qualified for extended school year (ESY) services. This summer we are thrilled to welcome over 80 students in Pre-KG through 12th grade from seven districts in Medina and Lorain counties! Students participated in weekly themed activities that centered around building independence, communication skills, social skills, and self-regulation strategies. Visits with therapy dogs, the fire department, a music therapist, and the parks department allowed our students to participate in activities that built on the skills worked on in the classroom. Many thanks are due to the Medina County Commissioners for providing space for so many years.
