



Medina County Art League has a raffle of donated artwork from participating artists in our annual Art in the Park event, held on the third Sunday each year in July. For several years the league has added to the raffle earnings making the Scholarship Awards an outstanding amount of money for the students. This year is no different. We have set aside \$2,800 to be distributed as follows: 1st Place - \$1,000; 2nd Place - \$700, 3rd Place - \$550; and Honorable Mention - \$350. This year we also have a \$200 Lois Steinmetz Memorial Award.

Since the teachers play a large part in the quality of work the students produce, I would like to thank them for helping their students develop their artistic abilities. 
