

Medina County Art League has a raffle of donated artwork from participating artists in our Art in the Park event, held annually on the third Sunday in July. For many years, the league has added to the raffle earnings, making the Scholarship Awards an outstanding amount of money for the students. This year is no exception. We have set aside \$2,600 to be distributed as follows: 1st Place - \$1,000; 2nd Place - \$700; 3rd Place - \$550; and Honorable Mention - \$350.

Janet Baran, Medina County Art League Scholarship Committee Chair, stated, "The four judges, who have over 140 collective years in art education, were impressed with the depth and artistic abilities that were presented by these high school seniors. Their job was challenging, to say the least. There were many portfolios exhibiting several strong works. The students who have been selected to receive awards have shown technical excellence in a chosen media, consistency in the work, and a distinct 'voice' carried throughout. Purpose

The Medina County Visual Art Festival—High School Senior Show provides a forum for students to see the works of other students from across the county. For students entering portfolios, the format is similar to a graduating art major in college who is required to hold a senior show.

Additionally, the Medina County Art League presents scholarship awards to the winners of its "High School Seniors Scholarships Program" during the Visual Art Festival.

An outgrowth of the Visual Art Festival is a year-round rotating student artwork display at the Medina Medical Office Building.

Rules

- High school seniors are eligible to participate if they attend a Medina County school district that is currently under contract with the ESC of Medina County for Fine Arts services.
- Scholarship portfolios, non-scholarship portfolios, and individual entries are accepted.
- Artwork must be original, school appropriate, created in conjunction with school assignments, and submitted with the knowledge and support of the student's high school art teacher.

Recognition

- Each winner of the Medina County Art League "Senior Scholarship Program" will receive a scholarship award.
- Gift cards may be awarded to winners in the non-scholarship and individual entry categories by the Educational Service Center of Medina County after the MCAL scholarship awards presentation upon approval by the Governing Board of the ESC of Medina County.
- All participants will receive a certificate of participation from the Educational Service Center of Medina County.
